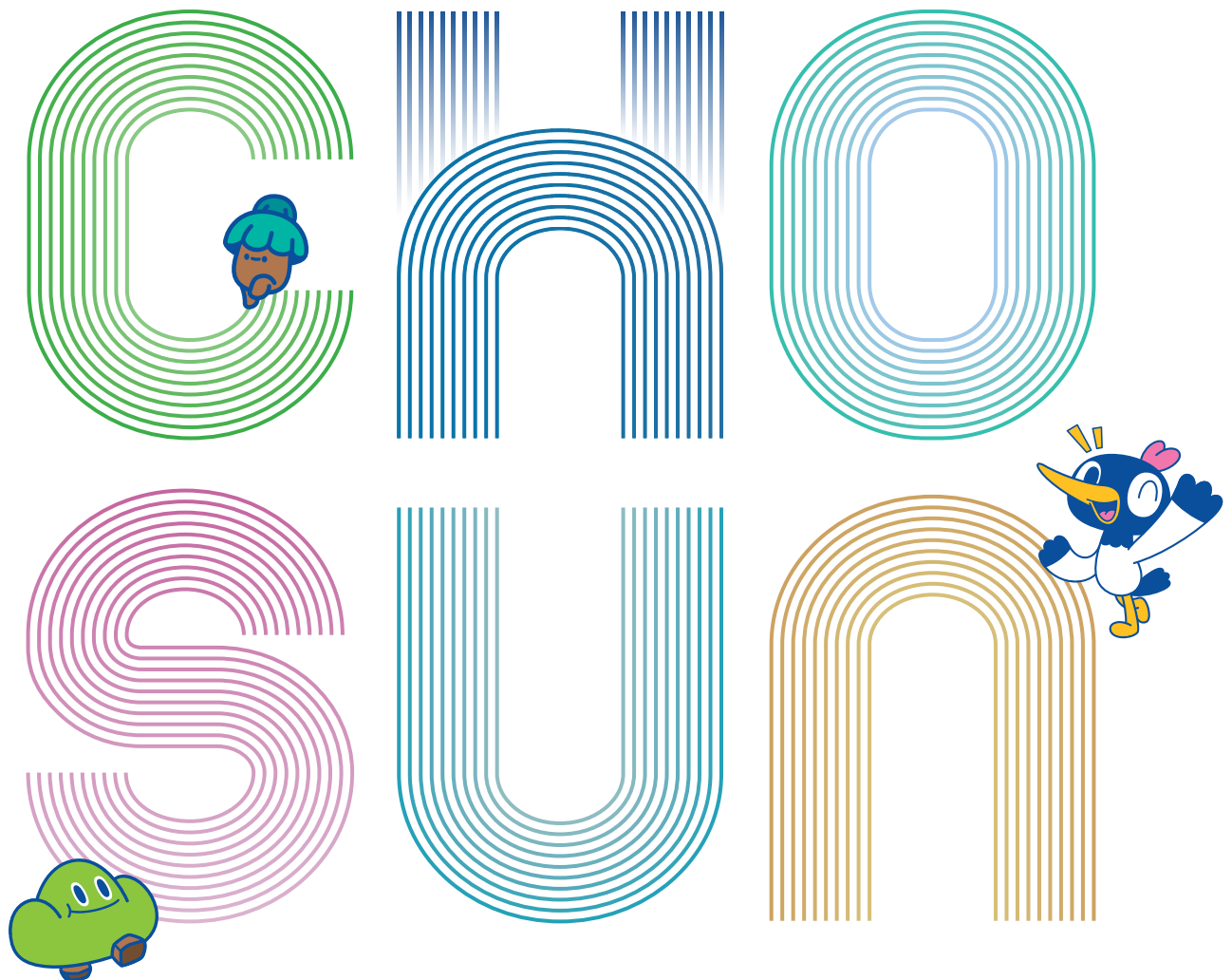

05 Important Notes

- 01 All certificates and documents must be submitted in **original form**, and **submitted documents will not be returned**. Applicants should prepare additional copies for future visa applications.
- 02 If a certificate of **expected** graduation (or completion) is submitted, the **official graduation (or completion) certificate** must be submitted before enrollment. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of admission.
- 03 Even if the online application is completed, failure to submit required documents within the designated period will result in rejection.
- 04 If any submitted documents are found to be false, or if admission was obtained through fraudulent means, admission or acceptance will be cancelled regardless of whether it occurs before or after enrollment.
- 05 Inquiries regarding the arrival of documents sent by mail will not be accepted. If the university requests additional related documents for review, the applicant must submit the requested documents.
- 06 Notarized translations must be done in Korean or English, and any verification procedures such as Apostille, consular verification, or CHSI certification reports should be confirmed with the issuing institution.
- 07 If the TOPIK level increases after the application submission, the updated TOPIK score report must be submitted before the interview for **admission scholarship** consideration. TOPIK score reports submitted after the interview will not be considered for admission scholarship evaluation.
- 08 Admission will be cancelled if, after acceptance, the applicant is unable to enter Korea due to denial of visa issuance or refusal by the relevant authorities.
- 09 Applicants accepted to more than one university must register at only one university. Violation of this rule will result in cancellation of admission or enrollment.
- 10 If tuition has been paid and admission is later cancelled, any refund will be subject to applicable processing fees borne by the student.
- 11 Newly admitted undergraduate and transfer students are not allowed to take a leave of absence or change majors during the first year of enrollment.
- 12 Applicants must provide accurate contact information (address and phone number) that can be reached at all times during the admission process.
※ Ensure no disadvantage occurs due to incorrect contact information during the admission process.
- 13 Matters not specified in the admission guidelines will follow Chosun University's academic regulations, and other matters will be determined by the university's **Internationalization Committee and Office of International Affairs**.

5. Graduation Requirements

▣ **School of Global Studies** : Earning minimum credits for graduation

▣ **General Departments**

- ① Obtain TOPIK Level 4 or higher (submit score report to the Office of International Affairs)
- ② Complete at least 6 credits of Korean language liberal arts courses for international students within the first year after admission
- ③ Graduation credits and additional requirements vary by department/major; it is strongly recommended to confirm with the department office after admission

6. National Health Insurance

- ① **Enrollment Date** : Automatic enrollment upon foreigner registration
 - Cannot enroll before completing foreigner registration. Therefore, if you need to use a hospital before registration is completed, or for safety, it is recommended to obtain separate insurance.
- ② **Monthly Premium** : 76,390 KRW
 - The above amount is based on 2025 rates and may increase in the future.
 - For stays in Korea of 6 months or longer, enrollment is automatic from the date of foreigner registration.
- ③ **Payment Method** : A bill will be issued to your residence; check the amount and account number on the bill and make the payment.
 - Automatic transfer / Credit card / Visit National Health Insurance office / Visit bank

11 Dormitory

- ① Freshmen may reside in the dormitory or off-campus (changes are not allowed after application submission).
- ② Dormitory residents must undergo a health check-up, and individuals with contagious or mental illnesses may be required to leave the dormitory.
- ③ Submit a Tuberculosis (TB) Test Result upon moving in
 - For visa applications, a copy of the TB certificate (in English) from the health check-up is also accepted.

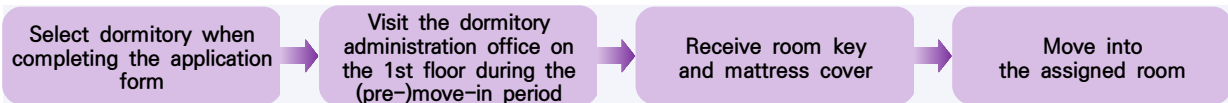
